Mayor and City Council,

Earlier today, we distributed an information memo with a revised schedule for public outreach for the City's inclusionary housing ordinance. Two recent legal cases involving other cities, particularly one decided last week, may have an impact on the content of the City's ordinance and the public outreach schedule. We are evaluating the impacts with the City Attorney's Office and you will shortly be advised of the issues and potential alternatives. It is likely that we will need to recommend changes to the proposed ordinance and the public outreach schedule at that time.
